Terms of Reference (TOR)

Engineer (Category D)

Background

The Smallholder Agribusiness and Resilience Project (SARP) is co-funded by the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) and the Government of Sri Lanka. It aims to contribute to reduce poverty among small-scale farmers and increase food security and nutrition in dry zones by building resilience and enabling rural households to access markets in geographies affected by climate change. The project is focused in select hotspots in Vauniya, Mannar, Puttlam, Kurunegala and Mathale districts aligned across the Deduru oya, Mee oya and Malwathu Oya river basins. The Total Project Finance Value is USD 59.57 Mn.

Scope of work:

The Engineer work under the supervision of the Senior Project Engineer, Deputy Project Director and Project Director. The Engineer will be responsible to align the planning, design, implementation and management of rural infrastructure supported by the project with the project development objective. He/she will on behalf of SARP oversee the various infrastructure planned under SARP in the respective Districts. He/she will report to the Senior Project Engineer, Deputy Project Engineer and Project Director, SARP and he/she will coordinate his/her responsibility with concerned authorities, with beneficiaries, with owners/caretakers of the to be developed infrastructure and within SARP with the financial, procurement and monitoring staff, the staff responsible for community engagement and the other components of the project.

Specific duties of the incumbent will include but are not limited to the following:

- Support SARP and its stakeholders and beneficiaries in planning the infrastructure to be supported by SARP
- Coordinate the planning for and of infrastructure works with the other activities undertaken by SARP
- Ensure commitment of future owners/caretakers of the planned infrastructure towards the management, operation and maintenance of the same, in close coordination concerned District staff and with SARP staff responsible for community engagement
- Ensure planned infrastructure is cleared by the environmental authority, and adheres to the environmental and social due diligence requirements agreed between GoSL and IFAD
- Pursue cost-effectiveness of designs, supervision and work implementation and proactively address potential cost overrides
- Prepare terms and specifications for engaging services for surveys, design, supervision and construction of said infrastructure in close cooperation with SARP's financial and procurement staff
- Review on behalf of SARP the performance of all service providers and contractors engaged for the development of infrastructure, in close coordination with the SARP finance and procurement staff. Official communication with contractors and service providers is to be internally coordinated before being channelled through the Deputy Project Director and Project Director;
- Ensure survey and construction works are implemented in keeping with the health and safety standards
- Ensure adequate quality control and quality assurance of the surveys, studies and construction works
- Maintain up-to-date record of planned and ongoing activities related to infrastructure, as well as of planned and achieved outputs, outcomes and impacts, in close coordination with the Senior Project Engineer

- Conduct ex-post reviews of completed works, their utilisation and management and their performance
- Submit periodic physical and financial infrastructure progress reports, including a list of issues (with proposed solutions) requiring management attention and follow-up
- Work with managing limited resources and minimum staff
- Any other duties as assigned by the Project Director, Deputy Project Director and Senior Project Engineer.

Qualifications/Experience Required:

1. A successfully completed Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering specially Irrigation related which is recognized by the University Grants Commission of Sri Lanka

And

- Associate Membership in the relevant field obtained from a recognized professional body

With

At least Seven (07) years post qualifying experience in the relevant field at a Managerial Level.

2. An officer of the Government All Island Services Class II/III or above or similar status in the relevant field.

And

An associate membership / a similar professional qualification obtained from a recognized professional institution in relevant field.

Other Required Qualifications and Experiences

- Managerial level experience in Engineering and Irrigation Management for three years would be highly desirable.

- Experience in building partnerships with the private sector and government agencies.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills in English and working knowledge of Sinhala and/or Tamil.
